Abstract:	<p>The California Healthcare Atlas consolidates the various data collected by the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) and creates a single point of entry to instantly access the information. It is a dynamic data set that allows the users to manipulate the data and create custom reports for exporting or printing as desired.</p> <p>Features include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Locate any healthcare facility by a wide variety of selection criteria</li> <li>▪ Select any hospital or groups of hospitals</li> <li>▪ Retrieve Admission, Emergency, and other admissions summaries (e.g. Number of discharges, Average Length of Stay, Average Charge etc)</li> <li>▪ Retrieve Facility Reports (Detail, License, Inpatient Summary)</li> <li>▪ Retrieve Financial Reports by specified time intervals</li> <li>▪ Retrieve Top 25 Diagnosis Related Group Reports</li> <li>▪ Find out if a location is in a health professional shortage designation area</li> <li>▪ Find summaries of vital statistics information from the Department of Public Health</li> <li>▪ Create Patient Origin and Patient Destination</li> </ul>

- Retrieve payer source, gender, age, race, ethnicity, patient groupings
- Retrieve facility demographics
